MATHS

SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will be consolidating their knowledge and understanding of place value within 20. We will also be learning about length and height followed by mass and volume. The children will use concrete, pictorial and abstract resources.

SCIENCE

SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will explore the basic needs of animals and humans, including food, water, and shelter.

Key Vocabulary: animal, human, food, water, shelter

HISTORY

SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will learn about historical and modern monarchs, focusing on their roles and significance.

Key Vocabulary: monarch, king, queen, reign,

GEOGRAPHY

SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will explore the four countries of the UK, their capitals, and national symbols.

Key Vocabulary: United Kingdom, country, capital, flag, map.

SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will get the opportunity to take part in Drumba. They will develop fitness and coordination by combining drumming movements with aerobic exercises to music.

Computing SUBJECT OVERVIEW FOR TERM

Children will program robots to move and complete tasks, learning about algorithms and sequences.

Key Vocabulary: program, algorithm, sequence, debug, robot

Children will explore rhythm and pitch in music through clapping, instruments, and movement activities.

Key Vocabulary: rhythm, beat, pattern, tempo, clap
