MATHS

Children will look at fractions, time, position and direction and statistics. Children will continue to build on the addition, subtraction and multiplication skills. **Key Vocabulary:** O'clock, half, quarter, third, divide, share, forwards, backwards, chart.

ENGLISH

Children will use 'Toby and Great Fire of London', 'Just So Stories', 'Illustrated History of Great Fire Of London' books to help inspire them to write a range of text types. **Key Vocabulary:** fire, wooden, King Charles, spread, fear, River Thames, help, guidance, support.

PHSE

This term we are looking at health and recognising their feelings. Children will investigate how to keep themselves healthy and happy. **Key Vocabulary:** healthily, understanding, oral hygiene, sun protection.

HISTORY

This term, year 2 will be looking at the Great Fire of London. Children will look at how and why the fire started and how it spread so quickly. **Key Vocabulary:** Samuel Peyps, London, River Thames, fire, spread, St Paul Cathedral

GEOGRAPHY

Children will learn about different continents and the importance of the Equator. They will compare Kenya and Leicester, investigating weather, landscape and culture.

PE

Children will continue to develop their fundamental skills, building on their throwing, running, jumping and catching abilities. They will also develop teamwork, sportsmanship, resilience and other key learning qualities.

COMPUTING

Children will use Music Lab on the computer to create music. They will explore how changing different musical dynamics can create, improve or alter digital music.

Key Vocabulary: tone, pitch, tempo

MUSIC

Children will learn about how technology has changed music. They will also investigate 20th-century music and explore how it is similar to and different from modern music. **Key Vocabulary:** technology, past, modern, music, tempo, pitch

RE

Children will learn about Christianity, what Christians believe, and how they show forgiveness. They will also investigate what makes a place sacred. **Key Vocabulary:** Christians, Church, Temple, Mosque, forgiveness, prayer, confession.
