



Year 3 Autumn Term Curriculum Maps



MATHS

To develop knowledge of place value, multiplication and division and addition and subtraction. The children learn to incorporate a range of problem solving and reasoning opportunities with a mastery approach. **Key Vocabulary:** hundreds, tens, ones, place value, dienes, column, partition, operations.

ENGLISH

Children will be focusing on the texts: 'Billy and the Minpins' and 'Journey'. The children will be developing knowledge and skills to write character descriptions, a persuasive letter and also a setting description.

Key Vocabulary: noun, verb, adjective, conjunctions, features.

SCIENCE

Children will be learning about 'Animals including humans' and also 'States of matter'.

Key Vocabulary: Animals, human, skeleton, muscles, relax, contract, solids, liquids, gases.

HISTORY

Children are learning about the 'Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age'. They will develop their understanding of BC and AD to aid their learning about changes in periods of time throughout History.

Key Vocabulary: Romans, invaders, raiders, Vikings, soldier, battle, artefacts, sources.

GEOGRAPHY

Children will be learning about the United Kingdom. They will learn about the different countries within the UK, counties, towns and cities. They will also begin to develop their knowledge of using maps.

Key Vocabulary: United Kingdom, Scotland, Wales, Ireland, maps, counties, towns, cities, rivers, features.

PE

Children will be developing their skills and knowledge in football and outdoor adventurous activities (OAA).

Key Vocabulary: agility, spatial awareness, balance, co-ordination, co-operation, teamwork, maps, diagrams, symbols, orienteering, plans, follow.

ICT

The children will be developing skills in 'Computing Systems and networks: Connecting computers' and also 'Creating Media: Stop-frame animation'.

Key Vocabulary: digital, input, output, process, networks, connections, e-safety, frames, animation.

MUSIC

Children will study various genres of music. They will learn to use Glockenspiels and Boomwhackers and perform as part of groups and whole classes. Children will explore pitch in singing.

Key Vocabulary pitch, volume, tempo, beat.

SMSC/RE/RHE

In SMSC the children will be focusing on what it means to be a good friend and how to support their peers. In RE the children will be learning about Christian beliefs based on the Creation Story.

Key Vocabulary: Seven days, God, Christianity, point of view.
