

Year 2 Spring Term Curriculum Map



ENGLISH

In English this term, the children will be writing narratives using the book 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' as well as writing fact files of Orangutans as well as David Attenborough.

Key Vocabulary: conjunctions, verbs, past tense.

HISTORY

The children will be looking at the Great Fire. They will know that it took place in 1666 and know about important facts observed by Samuel Pepys.

Key Vocabulary: fire, London, order, events, timeline, change, effect, Modern, past, present, buildings, King Charles II, Sir Christopher Wren.

ICT

This term we will be looking at programming quizzes and making music. Children will know that an algorithm is a sequence of commands which complete a task.

Key Vocabulary: rhythm, pulse, pitch, tempo, command, program, run, start

MATHS

In Maths we will be focussing on factions, time, statistics and position and direction.

We will also be recapping everything we have learnt over the year.

Key Vocabulary: fraction, equal, part, whole, hour, minute, clockwise, anti-clockwise.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we are looking at how is where we live different to Africa. Children will look at hemispheres and different countries in Africa.

Key Vocabulary: climate change, deforestation, ice caps, Amazon rainforest, carbon dioxide, impact.

MUSIC

In music we are looking at form and structure. Children will continue to look at the beat, pulse and rhythm.

Key Vocabulary: pitch, rhythm, 8 bar score, chorus, structure,

SCIENCE

The children will be looking at plants. Children will look at how we can keep ourselves healthy.

Key Vocabulary: mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, offspring.

PE

In PE we be continuing to develop the children's catching and throwing ability. They be learning to use a range of equipment hit and strike different balls.

Key Vocabulary: throw, hit, catch, balance, racket. balls run.

SMSC/RE/RHE

In PSHE we are going to be looking at health and wellbeing.

In RE we will be looking at what makes places sacred and Christian beliefs.

Key Vocabulary: Worship, belief, symbols, physical activity, sleep, health, screen-time
