# Year 3 Summer Term Curriculum Map

## MATHS

In Maths, we are learning fractions. We will be looking how to add and subtract fractions, finding fractions of an amount (e.g.  $\frac{1}{3}$  or 18) and comparing and ordering fractions.

**Key Vocabulary:** non-unit fraction, unit fraction, numerator and denominator.

## ENGLISH

We are reading Inside the Villains – an immersive book which shares the perspective from some of our favourite fairy tale villains such as The Big, Bad Wolf. We will be writing our own autobiographies in the perspective of the witch sharing all her deep, dark secrets.

## SCIENCE

In Science, we will be exploring man-made rocks and natural rocks. We will learn about how fossils are created and the different layers in soil.

**Key Vocabulary:** igneous rock, sedimentary rock, metamorphic, magma, permeable.

## PSHE

In PSHE, we are thinking about how we can stay healthy. We will be discussing dental hygiene, what our dental routines should look like and how we can improve our mental health and well-being too.

## GEOGRAPHY

What causes a natural disaster? We will be unpicking how earthquakes are caused through learning about tectonic plates. Furthermore, we will think about where volcanoes are located and the structure of a volcano.

## PE

Children will be developing their skills and knowledge in rounders, dance, athletics and cricket.

**Key Vocabulary:** solo, duo, categories, dynamics, timings, agility, power, speed track

## COMPUTING

The children will be developing skills in programming using Scratch and learning how to create media through desktop publishing.

**Key Vocabulary:** Scratch, sprite, movements, commands, structure. Text, images, advantages, disadvantages, communicate, font, font style

## MUSIC

Children will study various genres of music. They will learn to use Glockenspiels and Boomwhackers and perform as part of groups and whole classes. Children will explore.

**Key Vocabulary:** tempo, rhythm, bpm, bridge.

## RE

In RE, children will learn about what kind of world Christians believe Jesus wanted and think about how we can all make the world a better place.

**Key Vocabulary:** Bible, Disciplines, Sermon, Parable, Gospel, Humanist, Moral, commandments, compassion
